

Caravan Park User Guide during COVID 19 Pandemic

DO NOT leave home if you or anyone in your household has any symptoms.

PLEASE OBSERVE ON SITE SIGNAGE.

It is essential that caravan park users do not enter other users' caravans for the duration of their stay at the caravan park and adhere to all government guidelines in relation to the COVID 19 Pandemic.

We advise that you:

- Wash your hands regularly and for at least 20 seconds.
- Bring your own disinfectant wipes and before use, wipe water taps, any fixings or keypads that may have been touched or used by others.
- Keep hand sanitiser (at least 60% alcohol content) with you and wash your hands regularly.
- Use hand sanitiser before opening and closing any gates, key pads or locks.
- DO NOT touch your face after using anything that has been touched by other people.
- Observe "Social Distancing" with each other - 2 metres.
- DO NOT share any caravan equipment with other caravan park users.
- Minimise the contact with each other for example no handshakes.
- Wear gloves when using the bins on site, if this is not possible ensure hands are washed thoroughly after use.
- Book any additional nights that you may wish to stay using our online booking facility. Staff members are unable to book you in or accept cash payments at this time.

Please be reminded that the sluice room is the only facility currently available. All other facilities (showers/toilets/ laundry) remain closed until further notice.
